Rules of the game

Even though the JARS Auction is an informal, fun filled event, even the JARS have rules and so there will not be any misunderstandings, the *Official* JARS Auction Rules follow:

1- Ham or computer related goods only. Scanners are OK. Absolutely no carburetors, tires, washing machines, knives, guns, explosives, or weapons permitted. Also, a two meter HT strapped to a lawnmower CAN NOT be sold as a mobile radio!

- 2- No cleaning out the corner dumpster in search of something to bring to the auction. If it would not sell on eBay, don't bring it here.
- 3- If you have many small items such as a box load of small parts, you must put them up for auction as a single item. The time limit dictates that we must keep the junk moving to give everyone a chance to sell off his or her stuff.
